

Cross Necklace

Materials

- 6 pony beads
- Leather lacing, gimp, yarn, or rattail
- Glue

Instructions

Cut 3 to 3 ½ feet of leather lacing, gimp, yarn, or rattail- depending on head size. Find the center, and fold in half. Ifolding the folded end, make a shoelace (granny) knot. String two beads over both strands. Place one bead on each strand. Turning the fifth bead sideways, weave each strand through the center, so they cross. Place the last bead over both strands. Tie another shoelace knot. Tie another knot at the end of the strands. Use glue to secure the middle and top bead in place.

Notes

Extra beads can also be incorporated into the necklace.
